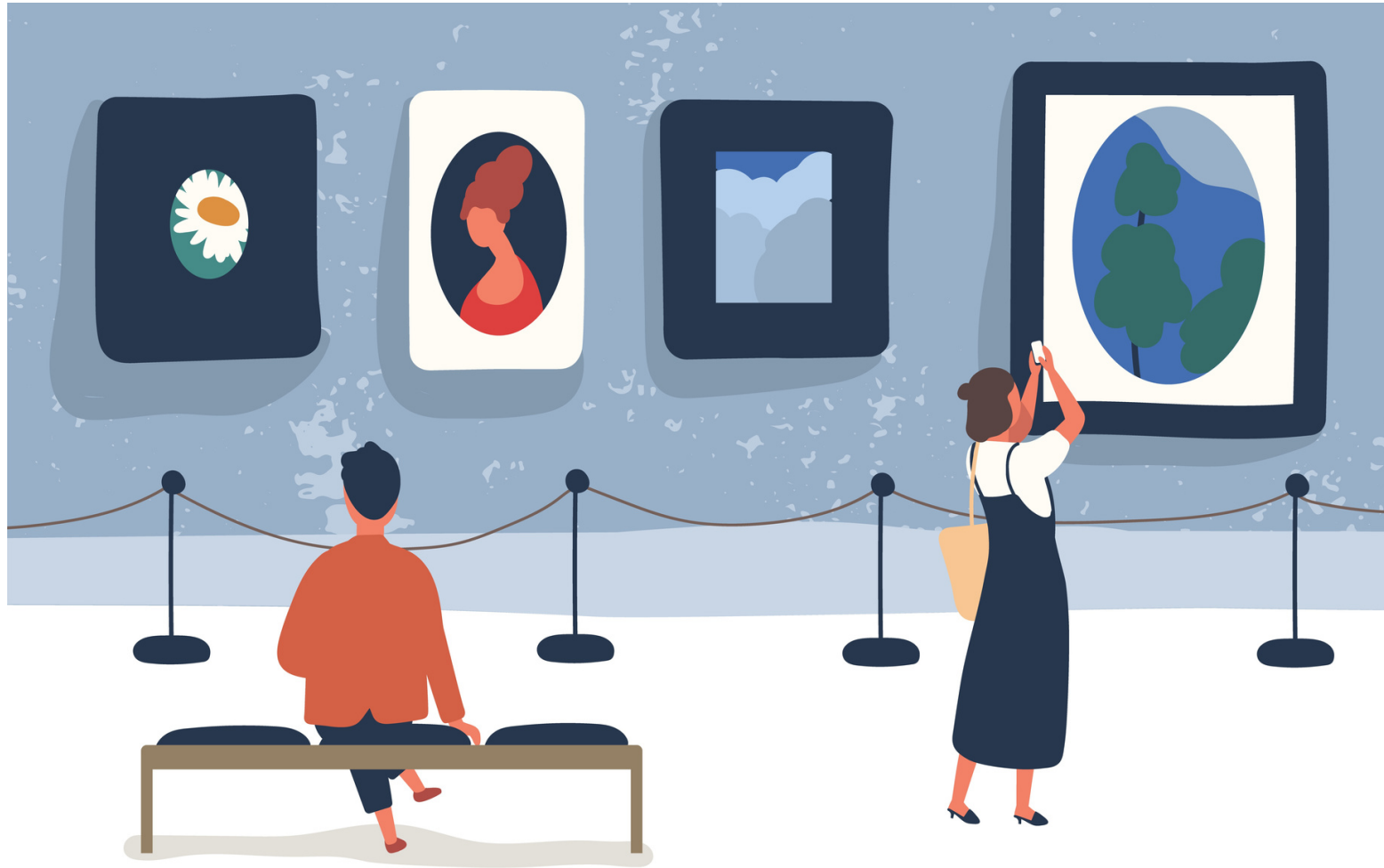

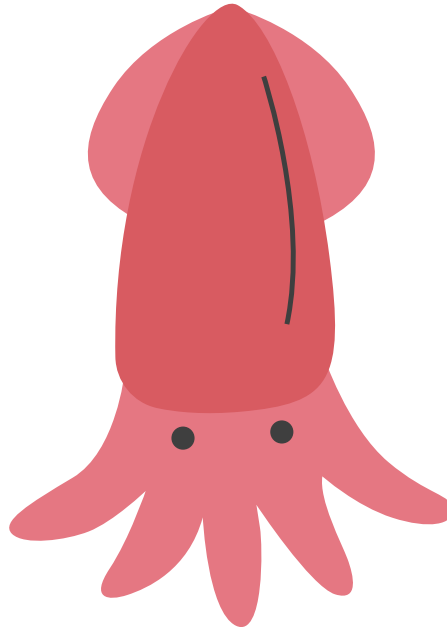

We can ring the train bell.



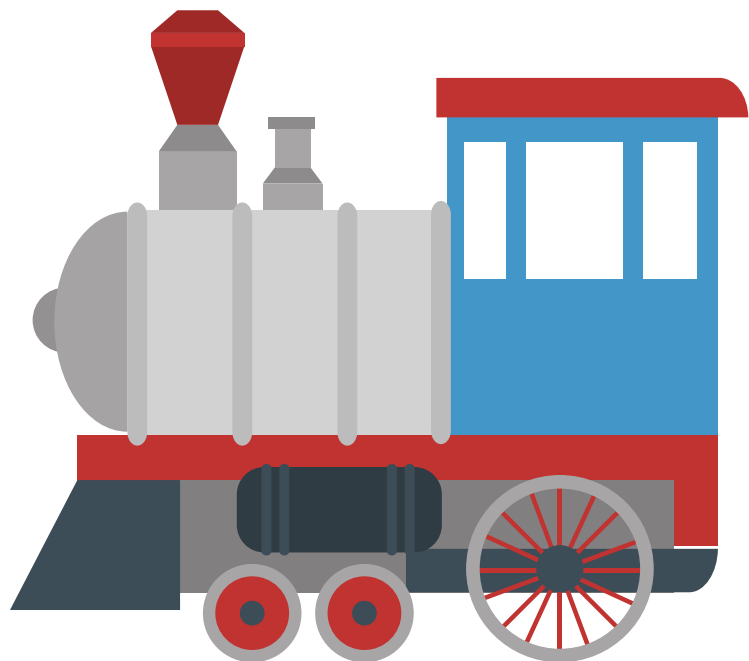
We can go inside the train cars.
